Instructions for use:

decomur Facade Finishing Filler is a ready-to-use filler for repairing and smoothing uneven wall and ceiling surfaces in damp rooms (such as kitchens, bathrooms and garages) and on facades. It is easy to smooth and hardens without cracking.

Properties:

- Ready to use
- Also suitable for damp rooms
- High strength

Technical data:

Raw material base: Plastic dispersion, mineral components, water, additives approx. 1.8 g/cm³

Density

pH value: 8

Substrate:

Can be used on all mineral substrates (e.g. concrete, masonry, gypsum, lime and cement plaster), emulsion and facade paints, etc. Not suitable for filling work on glass, plastic and metal. The substrate must be dry, sound, dust-free and free of grease. Prime highly absorbent, sandy and chalky substrates with decotric Tiefengrund LF. Fill deep holes and cracks with a cement-based filler (e.g. decomur Fassaden-Spachtel or decoplast Flächen- und Fliesenspachtel).

Application:

Apply the filler with a smoothing trowel to a maximum layer thickness of 5 mm and smooth. If a thicker application is required, a further coat can be applied after the first coat has dried. If necessary, the filled surfaces can be sanded after drying – in this case, treat the surface with decotric Tiefengrund LF before further processing to bind the sanding dust.

Consumption:

approx. 1.7 kg/m² at 1 mm application thickness

Notes

Not suitable for filling work on glass, plastic and metal. Do not use at object and ambient temperatures below +5 °C. Clean tools with water immediately after use.

Storage

Store containers tightly closed, child-proof and cool, but frost-free.

Disposal:

Only recycle containers that are completely empty.
